Directions To Chewore Lodge And Campsite By Road From Harare

- Leave Harare on the Lomungundi Road, heading in a north western direction.
- Stay on the road through Banket, Chinoyi (115 km from Harare) and Karoi (200 km from Harare)
- When you have reached Makuti a further 80 km from Karoi (Tip -fill up with fuel, this is the last point at which you will be able to.)
- Proceed along the same road in the direction of Chirundu, approximately 20 or so KM's beyond Makuti is the National Parks office in Marongora.

Here it is required that you stop and fill in park entry forms and pay the entry fees. They are a one off fee and are reasonable at the time of writing.

- Proceed from Marongora down the Zambesi escarpment. Please drive with additional care on this section of winding road that takes down into the Zambesi Valley.
- At the bottom of the escarpment there is a tsetse fly control with a boom across the road, about 100 meters further on is the turn off into the bush and onto dirt roads.
- Proceed through the control point at the turn off for 30km to a second boom gate. Here once again you need to sign in.
- Turn right and proceed approximately 41km, driving through this section you will encounter 2 bridges that have been washed away, there are detours across the river beds.
- At the end of the 41km stretch there is a turn off marked Kapirinengu and a sign for Chewore Lodge and Campsite 58km's.
- Turn left down this road, approximately 13 km along you will come to a T-junction
- Turn right and just keep on the road, approximately 10-15km from Chewore is another T-junction.
- Turn right again, you will cross a few small river beds and then come to the Chewore river crossing proceed until you come to the airstrip.
- Proceed directly across it, you are now 3km from the site, you will see the sign directing you into the Lodge and Campsite.
- Please note the directions are sign posted all the way from the turn off onto the dirt roads, just follow the signs, stay on the main dirt track unless a sign directs you otherwise, it is a fairly simple route in and well sign posted unless an elephant decides to push the signs over!
